Symposium on Newer Strategies towards TB Free India-2025

On the 61st Foundation Day of FWTRC, a Symposium on “Newer Strategies towards TB Free India-2025” was organized by FWTRC, Mumbai.

The Inauguration Programme started by lighting of lamp in presence of the following eminent dignitaries Dr. S. Venkatesh, Director General of Health Services, Dte.GHS, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, Dr. Sunil D. Khaparde, Deputy Director General, Central TB Division, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, Dr. Avinash Supe, Director ME & MH/ Dean, Seth GS Medical College & KEM Hospital, Mumbai, Dr Imran Farooq, Country Director-Challenge TB, The Union- SEA. Dr. Deepak Raut, Director, FWTRC, Mumbai.

At the outset, Dr. Deepak Raut, Director, FWTRC, welcomed all the dignitaries and participants for the programme. In his welcome address Dr. Deepak Raut presented the activities conducted by the institute in last year. Dr. S. Venkatesh, Director General of Health Services, Dte.GHS, New Delhi in his inaugural address firstly, appreciated the Director Dr. Raut & his team for their steady progress & achievement of FWTRC and his vision for taking it from a Training Centre way back in 1986 to a national level institute by planning to launch MD & MPH programs. He further said that it is a commendable progress by FWTRC & this institute can play an important role in capacity building, strengthening, monitoring & evaluation of various program at National level.

In his inaugural address Dr. Avinash Supe, Guest of honour, mentioned about rising prevalence of tuberculosis in city of Mumbai and the need to develop capacity building to tackle TB through public private partnership. He said especially in Mumbai if we want to reduce TB cases and control the tuberculosis, multi-sectoral approach need to be implemented strongly at all the levels. He appreciated the efforts taken by FWTRC for such a well-organized symposium with a very apt and need based topic. Eminent dignitaries & experts in the field of TB, Scholars and Program officers from MoHFW, GOI, Teaching Institutions, MCGM, State government, NGO's and Faculties, and Post-graduate students from Medical Colleges Participated in the Symposium.

“Leadership for achieving TB free India: Newer Strategies towards TB free India-2025

Dr. Sunil D. Khaparde delivered Dr. Indira Kapoor Oration on “Leadership for achieving TB free India: Newer Strategies towards TB free India-2025”. Dr. Sunil D. Khaparde, in his address informed that, under Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), the target is to achieve End TB by the year 2030. However, Government of India aims to achieve End TB target in India by 2025, five year ahead of the SDG target.

Dr. Sunil D. Khaparde emphasized that lot has been achieved under RNTCP and various initiatives have been undertaken recently under the programme. More than 2 crore TB patients have already been treated and 35 lakh additional lives saved.

Dr. Sunil D. Khaparde then informed about various initiatives recently taken under RNTCP. Active TB Case Finding Campaign for vulnerable and marginalized population has been carried out recently in which 26,256 TB cases were diagnosed and put on treatment.

However, challenges are still being faced under RNTCP. To tackle the issue of under reporting of cases in private sector, reaching the unreached like slums & tribal population, socially vulnerable and clinically high risk group is a daunting task. Further, Drug Resistant TB, Co-morbidities like HIV, Diabetes and morbidities due to tobacco use are prevalent. Lack of awareness about TB & poor health seeking behaviour among population remains a challenge.

Symposium on Newer Strategies towards TB Free India-2025

The Symposium on Newer Strategies towards TB Free India-2025 was organised on 6th July to celebrate the Foundation Day of the institute. In this symposium Dr Imran Farooq, Country Director-Challenge TB, The Union- SEA presented on Challenges to integrating service providers for TB Elimination. Dr. L. Swasticharan, Chief Medical Officer (NFSG)), National Tobacco Control Programme, Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GOI, New Delhi addressed on Expanding Horizons: RNTCP & National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP) Collaboration. Dr. Nagsen Ramraje, Professor & Head of Department of Pulmonary Medicine Sir JJ Hospital, Mumbai did a presentation on Advances in Diagnosis and Management of TB.

Thorat, Deputy Commissioner, FWTRC, Mumbai presented the finding of the study conducted by FWTRC in four states of India on Assessment of Advocacy, Communication & Social Mobilization (ACSM) activities to Eliminate TB in selected districts of India. The program concluded with a Valedictory session. The experts and Dr Deepak Raut, Director, FWTRC, Mumbai answered the questions raised by the audience. The question-answer session was moderated by Dr Neerja Arora, Challenge TB-Union.

These courses are i) Sanitary Inspector, ii) First Responder, iii) Diabetes Educator, iv) Home Health Aide and v) General Duty Assistant. These programs were inaugurated on 3rd November 2017 at the hands of Hon Dr. Deepak Sawant, Minister of Public Health and FW, Maharashtra in auspicious presence of, Dr. Ranjeet Patil, Minister of State, Maharashtra, Dept.
